

## Do your Pink & White Acrylic Nails turn Yellow?

"Keep your Pink & White Acrylic Nails "Bright" and "White" for the entire time between Fill-Ins, with your Tammy Taylor "Pink & White" Maintenance Kit."

- File the acrylic nail (pay special attention to the cuticle area) use the Tammy Taylor "180-grit Zebra file"

- Apply Tammy Taylor "Cuticle & Conditioning Oil" to the acrylic nail
- Buff the acrylic nail with the Tammy Taylor "Clean Finish Buffer" until smooth



- Wash hands



Apply 2 Coats of Tammy Taylor "A+ Coat" (A+ Coat is an Air-Dry, Non-Yellowing, High Gloss (U.V.) Acrylic Sealer Top Coat, to Keep your Pink & White Acrylic Nails from Yellowing)

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**Q: Why do nails turn Yellow?**

**A: There are many different reasons why your nails could yellow in between fill-ins:**

- **Using the "Wrong" Top Coat can cause yellowing**
- **Most Gel Top Coats can cause yellowing**
- **Sun and Sunscreens can cause yellowing**
- **Medications, Household chemicals, Smoking, etc...**

**Q: What can cause someone to Bite and Pick at their Nails?**

**A: When there are any rough or loose edges around the acrylic at the cuticle; these rough or loose edges are "irritating" and easy to pick at.**

**Q: What is Lifting?**

**A: Lifting is when the pink acrylic on the nail-bed pops up away from the natural nail.**

**Q: What is a Fill Line?**

**A: Fill "Lines" look like white or yellowish lines embedded in the pink part of the acrylic nail on the nail-bed; which can appear after a fill-in. Fill Lines are usually caused by Lifting.**

**Q: What are the Peely's?**

**A: White "Peely's" are sometimes seen around the cuticle area of the acrylic nails; the pink acrylic looks a little white around the edges, like a little pie crust edge.**

**All of these problems: Lifting, Fill Lines, Peely's, Yellowing, Biting and Picking, can be eliminated, by doing a simple "Maintenance" designed for Pink & White Acrylic Nails in between Fill-ins.**

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
